

## SUMMARY OF 2018 PROXY VOTING RESULTS

ExxonMobil thanks the many shareholders who returned their proxies. More than 3.6 billion, or over 85 percent, of the outstanding shares were represented at this year's meeting.

On average, over 97 percent of the votes were cast for the 10 persons nominated by the Board to serve as directors: Susan K. Avery, Angela F. Braly, Ursula M. Burns, Kenneth C. Frazier, Steven A. Kandarian, Douglas R. Oberhelman, Samuel J. Palmisano, Steven S Reinemund, William C. Weldon, and Darren W. Woods.

The Ratification of Independent Auditors, Advisory Vote to Approve Executive Compensation, and the four shareholder proposals received votes as detailed in the table below.
